#### NMI President's Report for 2022-23

**Therefore GO** was the theme and challenge for the Rocky Mountain District NMI for the convention year 2022-2023, to be the hands and feet of Christ in a hurting world.

Matthew 28:19 "Therefore go and make disciples of all nations, baptizing them in the name of the Father, and of the Son, and of the Holy Spirit."

Another year has passed by all too quickly. Here are some of the things that were accomplished, and not necessarily in chronological order:

- Completed and submitted the required year end reporting forms to Global NMI. Registered the NMI delegates and alternates for Global NMI convention with the assistance of Carol Skinner. Sent in the required paperwork for seating an alternate. The NMI delegates were Dee Dee Crider, Pastor Matthew Connally, and alternate, Sadie Carson.
- Produced the monthly district NMI newsletter, Mission Moments, and distributed it to all churches/and some individuals, and posted it on the NMI Rocky Mountain District group facebook page and on the Rocky Mountain District webpage ..thanks to Pastor Mike Holien.
- Continued the daily update to the group facebook page, and posted weekly "Partners in Prayer for Pastors" for Mondays at noon reminders as well.
- Answered many enquiries from local NMI presidents and others regarding NMI resources.
- Hosted three missionaries on Home Assignment in our district: Dr. Bill Kwon, Dr. Floyd Cunningham, and Dr. David and Rhonda Ackerman. Thanks to Rev. James Johnson for his assistance is scheduling host churches and thank you to all the churches who welcomed these missionaries into their homes and their churches, and for generously supporting them through Deputation offerings.
- Our district NMI gave \$1000 to sponsor the Stantons (Daryll and Verna), who were missionary speakers at RMD Kids Camp in August.
- Attended the Rocky Mountain District Leadership retreat in Thermopolis WY in October.
- Assembled 160 gift bags for the teens at Rejoice and attended Rejoice in Sheridan to hand these bags to the attendees.
- Attended a number of zoom calls for district NMI council and NDI, as well as for the planning committee for District Assembly and Conventions 2023.
- Met with Pastors Matt Tygart and Jarid Hundley, a number of times to discuss the 2023 joint convention and also with Lily Moore (NMI Council Member) to brainstorm and plan the convention, Thanks to both for their support and encouragement. I am blessed by their friendship.
- Did a site tour of the facilities at the Ramada Plaza Sheridan in the fall of 2022 with Lily Moore and met with staff to reserve rooms and negotiate costs. Also met with the new General Manager, along with DS Skinner and Lily Moore in March while attending Rejoice in March 2023. Made a third site tour with Lily Moore on May 23.
- Held an open zoom call with our globally assigned missionaries, Brian and Erin Ketchum, in France in October 2022.
- Met by zoom with Andrea and Matt Hopster, missionaries in Ecuador, and planned out their schedule for their home assignment tour for May 2023. Connected with host churches for contact and accommodation information for the missionaries.

- Organized the 2nd Wind River Christmas Blessing with the assistance of Pastor Bryce Roberts II. Thank you to all the churches and individuals who were a part of this opportunity. I know that your blessing touched the hearts of the recipients.
- Worked with the Nominating Committee (DS Bob Skinner, Colleen Skinner, Jean Ackerman, and Beverly Raymond) to prepare a ballot for the election of NMI council members at the 2023 NMI convention.
- Worked with Dee Dee Crider for the transitioning of the office of District NMI President. I know that she will do an excellent job in her new role on the district NMI council.

### **DEPUTATION - Convention year 2022-23 Home Assignment Tours**

**Three Missionaries from the Asia Pacific Region** - Immediately following District Assembly 2022, Dr. Bill Kwon, Field Strategy Coordinator for the Southeast Asia Field, started his tour of 20 churches in our district before heading to Nampa Idaho. Thanks to Craig and Leona Marquis for gifting him with the use of a vehicle for 3 weeks he was in our district and region.

Dr. Floyd Cunningham, distinguished professor of the History of Christianity, at Asia Pacific Nazarene Theological Seminary, in the Philippines, toured our district in September/October and visited 10 churches, two of which had their first experience of hosting a missionary on home assignment: Paskel's Place in Pavilion WY and Movement COTN in Polson MT. Dr. Cunningham also visited Laramie Connections, a Nazarene Compassionate Ministries center in Laramie WY.

Drs. David and Rhonda Ackerman, who are the Academic Dean at APNTS and Member Care/Mission Mobilization Coordinator (respectively) toured our district in October 2022, and were hosted by 10 churches. The Ackermans were living in Guam at the time of their tour.

Our district gave just over \$56,900 to deputation as reported by Funding the Mission.

**Mission Speaker at Kids Camp August 2022** - Daryll and Verna Stanton, former missionaries to Kenya, were the missionary speakers at Kids Camp. District NMI gave \$1000 to assist with the cost of travel and other expenses for the Stantons.

To end the convention year, missionaries Andrea and Matt Hopster will be touring our district in May and 14 churches have offered to host. Also in June, Peni Fakaua, missionary and DS of Samoa, and his wife will visit Billings and Laurel churches.
