

Supercamp2023 Camper Guidelines:

Teens are NOT to bring TV's, video game players of ANY type, fireworks, matches/lighters, knives, firearms, alcohol, drugs, or tobacco products. Possession of any of these items is sufficient grounds for up to dismissal from SuperCamp.

Cell phones, mp3 players, iPods, and other such personal electronic devices are brought at the student's own risk, and neither the staff of Rocky Mountain NYI or Abba's Haven Camp will be liable for any loss of or damage to any such items brought.

Part of the growth that comes through SuperCamp is the ability to **retreat** from normal life in order to hear from God and fellowship with others. Therefore, we ask that these personal electronic devices (if brought to camp) only be out at designated times instructed by the Camp Director on the first day of SuperCamp. This will primarily be during free times. There will be times when these devices are not permitted and camp staff reserve the right to confiscate them for up to the duration of camp if rules are disregarded.

Dress Guidelines:

It is our goal at SuperCamp to be the best representation of Christ that we can be. This should be evident in our speech, actions, and the way we dress. We are representatives of the Church and most importantly of Christ. We understand that ethics are not born out of a vacuum, therefore, the following is a guideline that set a minimum standard for modest dress. *Churches need to be responsible for helping teens exercise prudence and discernment in these matters.*

Bottom wear - must be long enough to cover the butt, boxers/underwear in any position the participants body rests (standing, sitting, bent over). While teenagers have differing body proportions as they grow "finger length" is usually a save means of measurement.

Shirts: No halter tops, crop tops, or low-cut shirts. Shirts may not be tied up exposing abdomen. Content and language offensive to the witness of Christ and the Church are not allowed. Tank tops are permitted but not spaghetti strap shirts.

Shoes – AT LEAST ONE SET OF TENNIS/RUNNING/COURT STYLE SHOES IS REQUIRED!

Swimwear – *The environment for swimming is a muddy and rocky river inside a tree line. Teens love to climb the dirt walls and jump off. Between the dirt, rocks, trees, and various unidentified plant life in the area it is suggested that all wear shorts and a t-shirt for protection!!* The following is the minimum and sponsors reserve the right to call out any swimwear that does not promote modesty.

Girls: 1-piece suit or a 2-piece. *No bikini with strings or no easily unfastened pieces (this is both modesty and to protect from wardrobe malfunctions in this environment). Absolutely no part of the breast (including cleavage) or butt cheeks may be visible. Again, girls are encouraged to wear shorts and shirt for protection. Also image a peer looking up at them as they climb the riverside wall: are they protected?

Boys: No “speedo,” tight fitting, or extra short swim shorts. Again, a shirt or rash guard is encouraged for boys as well!

Please be wise in your decisions of what you wear to SuperCamp.

Teenagers, you are in a crucial time in your lives where you need to be able to make responsible decisions on your own as you prepare for adulthood. With added responsibility comes greater opportunity to learn through correction. The choice to not follow these guidelines, one of the following actions will be taken: Asked to cover-up, asked to put something else on, call parents, removed from specific activities for the duration of camp, or sent home.
